**“Get to know the human side of Andean Culture”**

The Inca Trail (Capac Nan, in Quechua) is the name by which we call the vast network of Inca roads (over 40,000 km in total) built by the Incas to connect different parts of the vast empire. This network of roads linking various villages appeared in ancient times in what would now become the North of Argentina and Chile, Bolivia, Peru, Ecuador and Colombia, where the capital city of Cuzco was the main axis. Currently, many sections of this road have disappeared, have been deteriorated or are simply outdated. Royal Inca Trail to Machu Picchu begins in the town of Chachabamba, and goes up to the cloud forest through a road built 500 years ago, passing waterfalls, archaeological sites and with a variety of flora and specific fauna. The professionalism, dedication and experience of our guides and support staff will make this journey an unforgettable experience.

#### **Day 1: CUSCO - CHACHABAMBA - WIÑAYWAYNA – MACHU PICCHU – AGUAS CALIENTES**

Early in the morning, we will be transferred from the hotel to the station of Ollantaytambo, where we'll take the train that will leave us 104 km later: the starting point of this adventure in the land of the Incas. The Inca Trail begins on the bridge over the Urubamba River, and then we will attack a gentle climb to the cloud forest. In this way it is possible to observe a wide variety of flora and fauna and archaeological remains of Inca buildings. About three hours later, we reach the archaeological site of Wiñaywayna (name under which the locals call a variety of small orchids abundant in the region, which means "Forever Young" because they bloom all year). This will be the site of our lunch, and then we will restart our journey until the evening at the sector of Intipunku (Sun Gate), a place where we will have a outstanding view of the city of Machu Picchu. At that time, we will not go to Machu Picchu, but we will descend to Aguas Calientes to spend the night. But the next day, we shall discover the mysteries and secrets that have kept the Machu Picchu for centuries.

## Day 2: AGUAS CALIENTES - MACHU PICCHU - AGUAS CALIENTES - CUSCO

Early in the morning we will take a bus to go to the famous lost city of the Incas, we will see the sunrise and then we will begin a tour of about two hours in the places of interest. Then you will have enough free time to explore and discover the wonders of Machu Picchu on your own. After that we will descend by bus to Aguas Calientes to finally take the train to Ollantaytambo. There, a bus will be waiting to take you to Cusco and to your hotel.

Declared World Heritage by UNESCO in 1983, Machu Picchu (literally in Quechua: "Old mountain") was one of the great cities built in the process of conquest of the plains and jungle, rich in food, medicinal plants and coca. Considered astronomical and religious sanctuary of the Incas and one of the most brilliant works of architecture and engineering of all time, it has on top of that a lot of mystery and myth. Machu Picchu was abandoned and forgotten in time and quickly became covered with thick and dense vegetation during the four centuries that followed.

We will be transferred until 1911, when the American historian Hiram Bingham discovered the Lost City of the Incas.

- [Passengers who want to visit Huayna Picchu or Montaña \(In front of Machu Picchu\) have to let us know as soon as possible. Due to a new arrangement, the number of visitors is restricted to 400 per day. This means you need to buy new ticket, the cost is USD 65.00](#)

### Good to know

- Prices are subject to change without previous notice.
- The prices include: hotel accommodations. All transfers. Visits and excursions as per itinerary on a seat-in-car basis with the services of English-speaking local guides. Meals as per itinerary. Admission fees where applicable. On site logistical support of our Peru-based office.
- The prices do not include: International airfares, local airfares, international and local airports taxes, personal expenses, beverages, services not mentioned in the itinerary.
- Accommodation "Casa de Habitantes": Call home residents to the homes of the villagers, who are enabled rooms in the homes of the people, usually with the bathroom outside the room, no hot water.
- Luggage on board the train to Machu Picchu is restricted to one bag or backpack weighting 11 pounds or less and measuring 62 linear inches (length + height + width). Additional luggage can be stored at the hotel in Cusco.
- These prices are valid only for non-Peruvian citizens travelling with a valid passport and holding the Andean migration card, which is provided on the plane upon entering the country and sealed by the airport Immigration Services representative (Maximo 6 months stay).
- Please note the most Peruvian hotels have a check in time between 12:00 and 3:00 PM. If you have an early morning arrival, we recommend booking the previous night. And on the departure date, depending on your international flight schedule, an additional night in Lima might be necessary.
- Train services: In every tour is considered the train: Executive (incarail), Expedition (Perurail) if you want to improve your service vistadome (Perurail) will add USD 40.00 per person
- This tour is subject to a minimum number of passengers. Please call for further details.
- Tipping is not included on the tour and is at your discretion
- Temperatures and weather conditions in the Andes can vary considerably during the day, so we recommend taking layers of clothes that can easily be added or removed
- This tour can be strenuous, as it visits altitudes of over 14,000 feet above sea level
- The tour involves a number of early starts, considerable travel and changes in food and climate, so you'll need a healthy constitution and an adaptable state of mind
- Due to its nature the tour is not suitable for those with walking difficulties
